 - b. Fall beginning date in school: November 22. Spring beginning date in school: March 28.
 - c. Easter Break will give you time for travel in your host nation- Easter 2021 is April 17.
 - d. Will you have completed all requirements...? Circle YES
- 2. Optional Special Request Letter to Dr. Stachowski (location within a country, medical needs, other unique requests)
- 3. Acknowledgement of Responsibilities (signed by you)
- 4. Signed Release Statement (by you and a parent if they claim you as a dependent)
- 5. Autobiography (share details about yourself and your interests)
- 6. School Experiences (include upcoming student teaching placement in PA)
- 7. Course Listings (be sure to list the **TITLES** of the courses, not the numbers)
- 8. Additional Information (try not to leave anything blank/ include PSEA under memberships)
- 9. Pennsylvania State Police Criminal Record Check
- 10. Check for Registration and Program Fees (which go entirely to the Global Gateway for Teachers***) written to Indiana University (\$1150)
- 11. Attached budget and insurance form (one copy)*
- *NOTE: You will need to have health insurance that is valid overseas and become a member of PSEA (Pennsylvania State Educators Association) for liability insurance.
- ** Please type on forms/ no handwritten forms will be accepted. Submit to Dr. Bradaschia in 102 Chambers. Fall 2021, deadline is December 1, 2020. Spring 2022 deadline is April 1, 2021.
